 4. **Learning** : Meaning, Role of motivation in learning, Theories : Connectionism, Insight, Conditioning Classical and instrumental, discrimination learning- Verbal-learning methods, materials, organizational process.
 5. **Remembering and forgetting** : Meaning and nature, Reproductive and Reconstructive theories, memorization process and their determinants. Nature and theories of forgetting, Retroactive inhibition.
 6. **Thinking** : Meaning and nature, Varieties of thinking. Related concepts-Problem solving and concept formation, Role of set in thinking, language and thought, Theories of thinking-Central and peripheral.
 7. **Emotion** : Meaning and nature, Physiological correlates of emotion, Role of autonomic nervous system, Cerebral cortex and hypothalamus, Theories- James-Lange, Cannon Bard Activation.
 8. **Motivation** : Meaning, Basic motivational concepts-Need, Drive, Incentive, approaches to the psychoanalytic, S-R, cognitive Measurement of biological motives.
 9. **Intelligence** : Meaning and nature. Theories-Spearman's, Thorndike, Thurstone, Measurement of intelligence-verbal, non-verbal, creativity-
 10. **Personality** : Meaning and nature, Type and trait approaches. Determinants of personality-Biogenic and socio-Cultural, Personality assessment- Questionnaire, and projective techniques.
